BUSINESS **ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS**

The Business Achievement Awards (BAA) are an individual educational program for high school members in FBLA. Through the four levels of BAA, students have the opportunity to enhance their leadership skills, expand their business knowledge, contribute to their local communities, and earn state and national recognition by immersing themselves in their school and communities.

CHAMPION CHAPTER

The Champion Chapter challenge is a membership recruitment and engagement-focused program in which chapters earn points and recognition through a series of chapter activities. Champion Chapter activities drive membership growth and enrich every aspect of the chapter experience. Chapters can participate in one or all of the five sections, each designed to improve a different part of the chapter. Eligible Champion Chapters that rise to the challenge will earn national recognition and awards, reflecting their accomplishments and points gained.



STATE & LOCAL **OFFICE**

At all levels of FBLA, members are given the opportunity to grow as community-minded leaders and make an impact on students across the country through local, state, and national office. Local & State Officers are the foundation of our organization and lead anywhere from hundreds to thousands of students during their term.
